4. David has zero fewer oranges than Paul. Paul has three oranges. How many oranges does David have?

5. Brian has eight pears. Steven has eight pears. How many more pears does Steven have than Brian?

6. Four peaches were in the basket. Some of the peaches were removed from the basket. Now there are two peaches. How many peaches were removed from the basket?

7. Some apples were in the basket. Two apples were taken from the basket. Now there is one apple. How many apples were in the basket before some of the apples were taken?

8. Six apples are in the basket. Four apples are taken out of the basket. How many apples are in the basket now?

9. Seven marbles were in the basket. Some of the marbles were removed from the basket. Now there are two marbles. How many marbles were removed from the basket?

10. Steven has three fewer pears than Brian. Brian has eight pears. How many pears does Steven have?
