2. Allan has three fewer plums than Billy. Billy has five plums. How many plums does Allan have?

3. Two pears are in the basket. Two pears are taken out of the basket. How many pears are in the basket now?

4. Four peaches are in the basket. Three are red and the rest are green. How many peaches are green?

5. Five balls were in the basket. Some of the balls were removed from the basket. Now there are three balls. How many balls were removed from the basket?

6. Some apples were in the basket. Three apples were taken from the basket. Now there are three apples. How many apples were in the basket before some of the apples were taken?

7. Seven marbles are in the basket. Six are red and the rest are green. How many marbles are green?

8. Six apples were in the basket. Some of the apples were removed from the basket. Now there are four apples. How many apples were removed from the basket?

9. Eight balls are in the basket. Four balls are taken out of the basket. How many balls are in the basket now?

10. Some marbles were in the basket. Seven marbles were taken from the basket. Now there is one marble. How many marbles were in the basket before some of the marbles were taken?
