1. Eight oranges are in the basket. Eight are red and the rest are green. How many oranges are green?

2. Paul has zero fewer pears than Billy. Billy has three pears. How many pears does Paul have?

3. David has seven balls. Jake has nine balls. How many more balls does Jake have than David?

4. Four marbles were in the basket. Some of the marbles were removed from the basket. Now there are two marbles. How many marbles were removed from the basket?

5. Five plums are in the basket. Two plums are taken out of the basket. How many plums are in the basket now?

6. Some peaches were in the basket. Two peaches were taken from the basket. Now there are four peaches. How many peaches were in the basket before some of the peaches were taken?

7. Billy has six apples. Paul has eight apples. How many more apples does Paul have than Billy?

8. Five apples are in the basket. Four apples are taken out of the basket. How many apples are in the basket now?

9. Five plums were in the basket. Some of the plums were removed from the basket. Now there are three plums. How many plums were removed from the basket?

10. Jake has one fewer ball than Steven. Steven has four balls. How many balls does Jake have?
