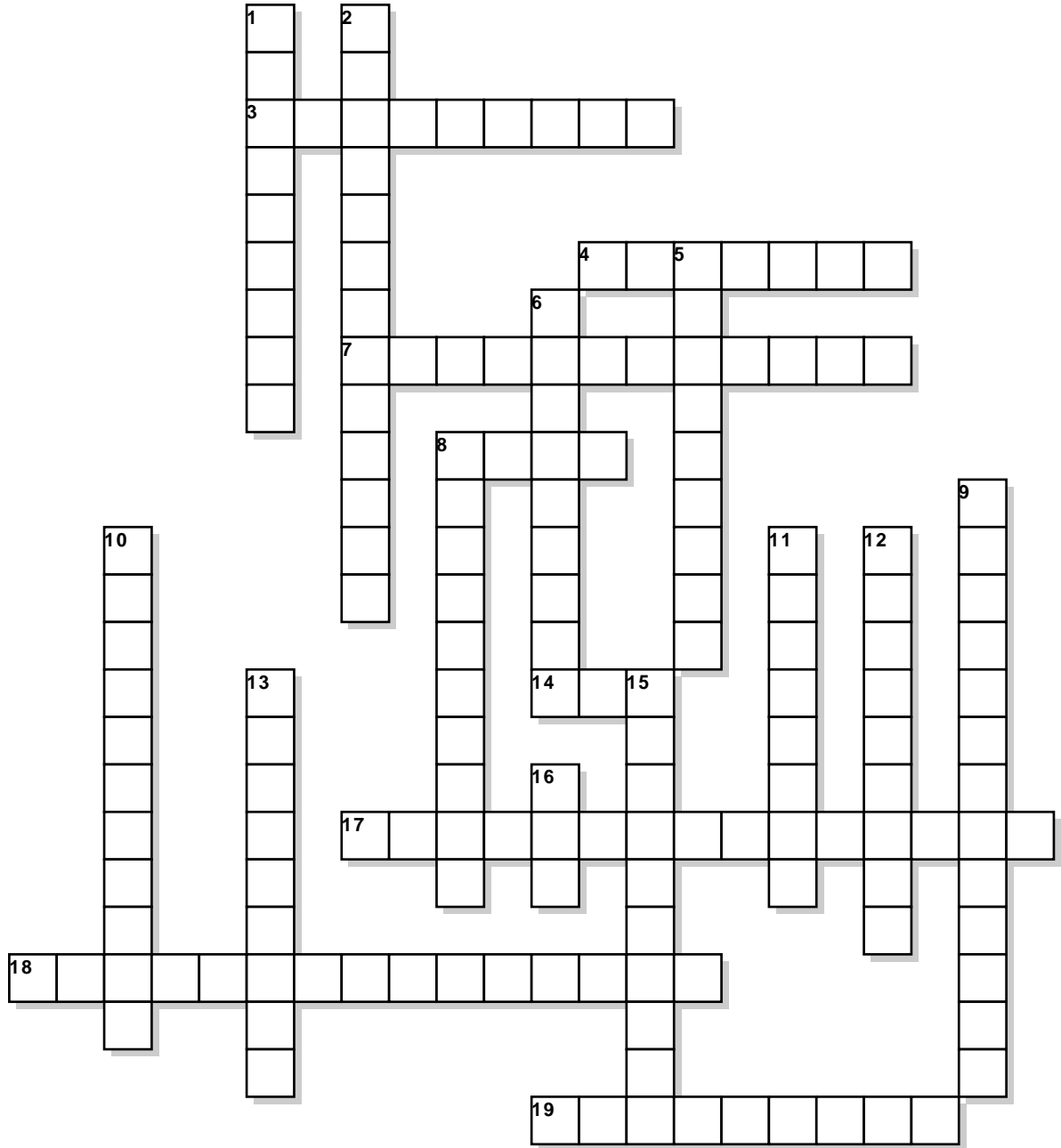


Tom Sawyer Crossword Puzzle



Across

- 3 The schoolmaster. He seems a slightly sad character: his ambition to be a medical doctor has been thwarted and he has become a heavy drinker and the butt of schoolboy pranks.
- 4 A Welshman who lives with his sons near the Widow Douglas's house. He responds to Huck's alarm on the night that Injun Joe intends to attack the widow.
- 7 A well-dressed new boy in town. Like Amy Lawrence, he gets caught in the crossfire of Tom and Becky's love games.
- 8 Tom's sweet, almost saintly cousin. She holds a soft spot for Tom. Like Sid, she is well behaved, but unlike him, she acts out of genuine affection rather than malice.
- 14 Tom's half-brother. He is a goody-goody who enjoys getting Tom into trouble. He is mean-spirited but presents a superficial show of model behavior.
- 17 A kindhearted, pious resident of St. Petersburg whom the children recognize as a friend. Tom knows that she will give him and Becky ice cream.
- 18 The son of the town drunk. He is a juvenile outcast who is shunned by respectable society and adored by the local boys, who envy his freedom.
- 19 Tom's aunt and guardian. She is a simple, kindhearted woman who struggles to balance her love for her nephew with her duty to discipline him.

- 1 The novel's protagonist. He is a mischievous boy with an active imagination.
- 2 Becky's father, the county judge. A local celebrity, he inspires the respect of all the townspeople.
- 5 Tom's "bosom friend" and frequent playmate. "Two souls with but a single thought."
- 6 One of Tom's friends, whom Tom persuades to whitewash Aunt Polly's fence.
- 8 A hapless drunk and friend of Injun Joe. He is kind and grateful toward Tom and Huck, who bring him presents after he is wrongly jailed for Dr. Robinson's murder.
- 9 Judge Thatcher's pretty, yellow-haired daughter. She is the "Adored Unknown" who stirs Tom's lively romantic sensibility.
- 10 Tom's former love. Tom abandons her when Becky Thatcher comes to town.
- 11 A violent, villainous man who commits murder, becomes a robber, and plans to mutilate the Widow Douglas.
- 12 The minister of the town church.
- 13 The somewhat ridiculous Sunday school superintendent. He rewards Tom with a Bible.
- 15 A respected local physician. He hires Injun Joe and Muff Potter to dig up Hoss Williams's grave.
- 16 Aunt Polly's young slave.
